THE MYSTERY OF THE HOLY TRINITY

“O Lord our Lord, how glorious is your name over all the earth” (*Psalms 8:2*). These words from the psalm bring us trembling and adoring before the great mystery of the Most Blessed Trinity, the feast of which we solemnly celebrate today. Yet, the extent of the world and the universe, though boundless, does not equal the immeasurable reality of the life of God. Before him, we must more than ever humbly accept the call of the wise man in the Bible when he says: “Let not your heart be quick to make a promise in God’s presence. God is in heaven and you are on earth” (*Ecclesiastes 5:2*).

God is actually the only reality beyond our powers of measuring, observing, controlling, of gaining exhaustive knowledge. That is why he is God: because he measures us, rules us, watches us, understands us, even when we might be unaware of it. But if this be true for the Godhead in general, it is all the truer for the mystery of the Trinity, the typically Christian mystery, of God himself. He is at the same time Father, Son, and Holy Spirit. But it is not a matter of three separate Gods – that would be blasphemy – nor of simply diverse and impersonal modes of presenting himself on the part of one Divine person. This would mean radically impoverishing the richness of his interpersonal communion.

We are in a position to know more about what the One and Triune God is not than about what he is. If we could explain him adequately with our reason, that would mean that we should have captured and reduced him to the measure of our minds.

However, this is the Christian novelty: *the Father* loves us so much as to give us his Only Begotten Son; through love, *the Son* poured out his blood for our sake; and *the Holy Spirit* was actually “given to us” in such a way as to bring into us that same love with which God loves us (*Romans 5:5*).

SECOND COLLECTION

It is time again for our annual offering for the *Church in Latin America*. Although the people are faith-filled, the needs in this region of the world are great – and often seem insurmountable. The distance between rural areas and deteriorated roads make it difficult for some communities to have Mass celebrated regularly. Language barriers can make catechetical materials difficult to produce. We are called to share our faith with all, and today’s collection is a prophetic and bold way to do it.

For the past fifty years, the United States Conference of Catholic Bishops has helped twenty-five countries in Central and South America to confront challenges to the faith. With the support of all the Catholic faithful, we have funded activities that promote an encounter with Jesus Christ so that the faithful can become missionary disciples.

On the very same weekend, 15 and 16 June, we are also conducting the *Catholic Home Missions Appeal*. The Church has great needs around the world and the United States is no exception. Many dioceses here at home face challenges due to priest shortages, lack of funds, remote geography, or impoverished parishes. Forty-two percent of all dioceses in the USA receive Catholic Home Missions support for evangelization, catechesis, ministry formation, and other areas of faith development. Your support of this collection will help our neighbors strengthen the Church at home to continue to provide essential pastoral outreach in home mission dioceses.

I am counting on your usual generosity again this year. Your support for each of these collections is vital. When you contribute, you become an instrument of peace and join with other Catholics in solidarity with the needy.
