There is always a long delay between submitting the order and the installation date and we would like to be able to do so as early as possible. National 54 Day Rosary Novena

It is abundantly apparent, and becomes more so day by day, that our culture and society are in spiritual crisis. The Archdiocese of New York will participate in the *National 54 Day Rosary* from August 15 through October 7, 2015. The primary novena intention will be "for the Family and Marriage" for peace, for human life and religious freedom. The plan is to pray the rosary for 54 straight days individually, or with friends and neighbors: 27 days in petition from August 15 through September 10, 2015, and 27 days in thanksgiving from September 11 through October 7, 2015. Suggestions as to implement the plan here in the parish are welcome.

RELIGIOUS EDUCATION REGISTRATION**Children grades 1 to HS:**

Registration and re-registration takes place from Tuesday to Friday 11am to 6:30pm in the rectory during regular office hours.

(A) First time registrations: Baptismal certificates are necessary for children already baptized, otherwise a birth certificate.

(B) Re-registration: Please bring the applications, filled out, distributed at the Parent-Teacher Conference.

Adults: Those needing Baptism, Communion or Confirmation are prepared through the RCIA program. Registration takes place from Tuesday to Friday 11am to 6:30pm in the rectory during regular office hours. The RCIA process for preparing adults starts on Tuesday August 4 at 7pm.

Dressing for Mass

A parishioner has suggested that it would be timely to give a reminder that some thought should go into how we dress for mass, especially during the summer months. Just as we should be in a state of grace and have fasted from food and drink except water for one hour before receiving Holy Communion, we can make a remote preparation for the Holy Sacrifice by giving some thought as to how to dress. We can convey an unintended message to ourselves and others when we dress for Mass in the same way that we dress to walk the dog or take down the garbage, for a picnic at the beach, for a day in the park or a night at a club. On the other hand, we contribute to a reverent environment for everyone in church when we dress simply and comfortably but appropriately.

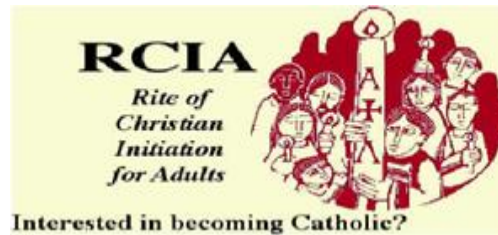
