Mother Mary Angelica, the cloistered nun who started the global Catholic channel EWTN, died on Easter Sunday.



She had once described why she got started in media:

“My desire to feed the people of God was a constant incentive. My dream was to reach the common man, encourage him to pray and aspire to be holy, provide family programming, and be a vehicle for the Church.”

A favorite quote of hers was 2 Corinthians 3:18, now inscribed in the crypt where her earthly body rests:

“And we, with our veiled faces, reflecting like mirrors the brightness of the Lord, all grow brighter and brighter as we are turned into the image that we reflect. This is the work of the Lord Who is Spirit.”

Do pray, my brothers and sisters, that each one of us might shine only brighter and brighter each day with the love of Jesus. This will make every bit of difference to the people in our lives and for the salvation of our souls.

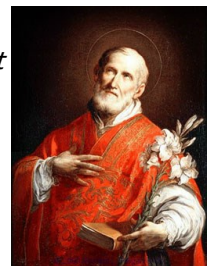

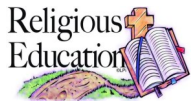
