OPENING HYMN

Leader: In the name of the Father, and of the Son, and of the Holy Spirit. **All: Amen.**

NOVENA INTENTION AND PRAYER

Leader: "Today bring to ME meek and humble souls and the souls of little children and immerse them in my mercy. These souls most closely resemble my heart. They strengthened Me during my bitter agony. I saw them as earthly angels, who will keep vigil at my altars. I pour out upon them whole torrents of grace. Only the humble soul is capable of receiving my grace. I favor humble souls with my confidence."

Most Merciful Jesus, you have said: "*Learn from me for I am meek and humble of heart,*" and "*Let the children come unto me.*" Receive into the sanctuary of your most compassionate heart all meek and humble souls and the souls of little children. These special souls transport all in heaven into rapturous ecstasy. These souls are the heavenly Father's favorites. They are a sweet-smelling bouquet before the throne of God, who takes great delight in their fragrance. These souls, O Jesus, have a permanent dwelling place in your most compassionate heart, where unceasingly they sing joyful hymns of love and thanksgiving for your great mercy. **R. Alleluia, Alleluia, Alleluia.**

Eternal Father, God of steadfast love, turn your merciful gaze upon meek souls, upon humble souls, and upon the souls of little children who are enfolded in the sanctuary of Jesus' most compassionate heart. These souls bear the closest resemblance to your Son. Their fragrance rises from the earth and reaches to your throne. Father of mercy and goodness, I beg you by the love you bear these souls and by the delight you take in them to bless the whole world, so that all souls together may sing the praises of your mercies for endless ages. **R. Alleluia, Alleluia, Alleluia.**

Holy Spirit, River of Mercy, proceeding from the Father and the Son, fill our hearts with endless joy as we celebrate the Paschal Mystery from which flows the endless mercies of God. **R. Alleluia, Alleluia, Alleluia.**

Leader: Glory be to the Father, and to the Son, and to the Holy Spirit!
All: Holy! Holy! Holy is the Lord God Almighty, Who was, Who is, Who is to come. Amen. Amen. Amen.
