**Dr. Stephen L. Dewey Ph.D. to Speak on  
"Addiction and the Adolescent Brain"**

On Tuesday April 9, 2019 the Our Lady of Lourdes High School community invites you to join us in welcoming Dr. Stephen L. Dewey, from the NYU School of Medicine, who will speak on the topic of **Addiction and the Adolescent Brain**. Prior to Dr. Dewey's presentation, the Council of Addiction Prevention and Education of Dutchess County (CAPE) will set up an educational intervention, designed for parents and guardians, that allows participants to explore a model teen bedroom and identify paraphernalia and other possible indicators of substance use/misuse. ## TODAY'S GOSPEL MESSAGE by Rev. William J. Reilly

**"I consider everything as a loss because of the supreme good of knowing Christ Jesus my Lord. For his sake I have accepted the loss of all things and I consider them so much rubbish, that I may gain Christ and be found in him...but I continue my pursuit in hope that I may possess it, since I have indeed been taken possession of by Christ Jesus."**

We measure so many things in life under the banner of profit and loss. I look for a bargain, I go out of my way when something is on sale, even when I don't need it. How shocking it is as I read Paul, as he speaks of rubbish what many consider of great value.

Paul teaches us that what really matters is knowledge of Christ Jesus, not just knowing about Him, but having a personal relationship with Him. There is nothing as important as knowing Jesus, His great love for me, and His redeeming sacrifice, as we draw closer to Holy Week. May we make an extra effort to be freed from possessions and be possessed by Him.
