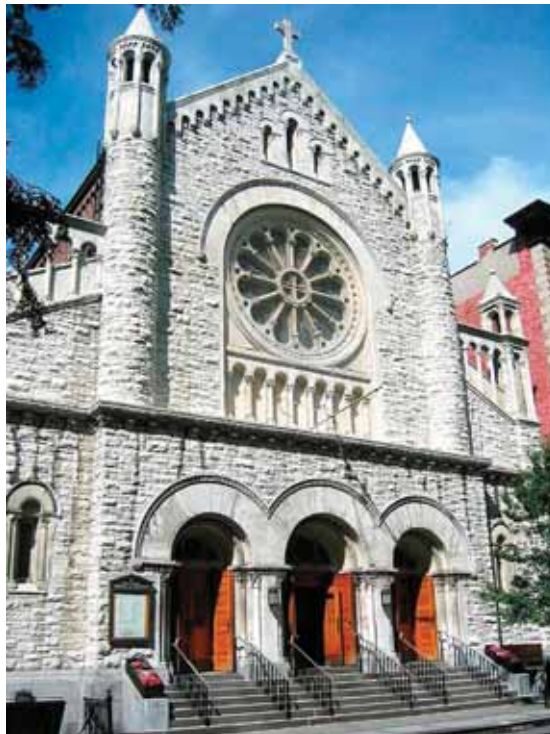

Dear Parishioners and Friends of Ascension,

National Catholic Schools Week is the annual celebration of Catholic education in the United States. It starts the last Sunday in January (today) and runs all week, through Sunday, February 6. The theme for the National Catholic Schools Week 2016 is "Catholic Schools: Communities of Faith, Knowledge and Service."

Catholic schools offer academic excellence and faith-filled education for students nationwide. National test scores, high school graduation rates, college attendance and other data show that Catholic schools frequently outperform schools in both the public and private sectors. While some Catholic schools are challenged by declining enrollments and school closures, the good news is that there is a strong demand and enthusiasm for Catholic schools. Thirty-two percent of Catholic schools have waiting lists for admission

This week we will be both touting and celebrating our school in conjunction with Catholic Schools Week. A special Mass will be celebrated on Tuesday, February 2, 2016 at 8:30a.m. The children from the school will be present. During the week, the children will be participating in Speech and Religion Bees, etc. . . Our school has been serving our local community for more than 100 years and we hope to continue our commitment to the education and spiritual formation of our children for many more years into the future. Thank you for your continued support of our regional school.

This summer our parish will be returning to the Dominican Republic for a fourth year of Mission. The mission will take place from Sunday, July 3rd until Sunday, July 10th. This year our Mission will bring us to The Parish of Holy Cross (Santa Cruz), which is in Estorga. The community of Estorga is in the town of Guerra. As in the past, the purpose of the mission is two-fold; the Parish Mission is both spiritual and medical. Each time we are at Mass, we hear God's word proclaimed and then we are sent forth to act on that word and put God's word into practice. The other part of our mission will include a 2 day Medical Clinic, As we begin our planning, I would like to again reach out to all medical professionals from the parish. Because of space limitation, this year we hope to be about 30 in number. This is a very humbling, life changing experience. If you think you might be interested in going or would like more information, please get in touch with me as soon as possible.

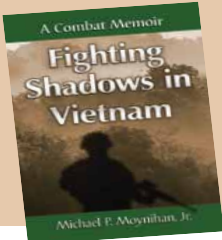
