## The Weekly Article from

It is always great to have their message and music present at the conference. We were able to listen to some amazing speakers throughout the weekend including Ennie Hickman, Fr. Michael Schmitz, and Sr. Miriam Heidlan. They all talked about how we can encounter Christ in all sort of ways in our lives. Saturday, we were able to go to Mass and spend some time in adoration in the morning and in the evening. The power of the Holy Spirit was truly with us during those times.
