Historical landmark of Jeremiah.

JEREMIAH 3: 6-10- parable of the two sisters JEREMIAH 3: 14- 18 JEREMIAH 4: 5-13 -invasion of the enemy of the north -JEREMIAH 4: 23-28- desolation and agony in the land. JEREMIAH 5: 1-6 - moral depravity of Judah. JEREMIAH 5: 15-19 - announcement of divine punishment. JEREMIAH 5: 26-31—corruption of the ruling classes. (kings, priests and false prophets)

WEDNESDAY SEPTEMBER 13- PART IV-THE PROPHET JEREMIAH - CHAPTERS 6 TO 12- During kings Josiah {627-622), Joachim (609-597 B.C), Sedekiah (597-587 B.C) and Godolias (587 ... B.C) JEREMIAH 6: 1 -5 -The siege of Jerusalem. JEREMIAH 6: 9-15- the wrath of the Lord. JEREMIAH 6: 22-26- Advancement of the invading people. JEREMIAH 7: 3 -15 -Announcement of the destruction of the Temple. JEREMIAH 7: 21-28 - Against purely external worship. JEREMIAH 8: 8-13 Against the scribes, the priests, and the false prophets. JEREMIAH 10: 1-16 -The idols and the Living God -JEREMIAH 11: 1- 14 - Exhortation to the fulfillment of the Covenant. JEREMIAH 12: 1-17- Prosperity of the wicked - judgment and salvation of the neighboring peoples.

WEDNESDAY SEPTEMBER 20 - PART V - THE PROPHET JEREMIAH - CHAPTERS 13 TO 17- JEREMIAH 11: 1-8- exhortation to the fulfillment of the covenant- JEREMIAH 11: 18-23- Conspiracy against Jeremiah in Anathoth. JEREMIAH 12: 1-6- the prosperity of the wicked, why is it so evil with the righteous?- JEREMIAH 12: 7-13- The devastation of Judah. JEREMIAH 13: 1-11- the symbolism (OT) of the damaged belt. JEREMIAH 14: 1-6 -the great drought. JEREMIAH 14: 7-9- supplication for the people -JEREMIAH 14: 10-16 - negative response of the Lord. JEREMIAH 15: 10-18 - bitter complaint of Jeremiah -JEREMIAH 16: 1-5 - called to live a solitary life. JEREMIAH 17; 19-27- Exhortation to the observance of the Sabbath.

WEDNESDAY SEPTEMBER 27- PART VI- THE PROPHET JEREMIAH IN JERUSALEM -JEREMIAH 17:5-8 the happiness of him that trusted in the lord, and cursed him that trusted in men. JEREMIAH 18: 1-17-the potter's workshop. JEREMIAH 18: 18-23 -conspiracy against Jeremiah. JEREMIAH 19: 1 -15 -the broken pitcher (OT) JEREMIAH 20: 1-6 -a prophecy against the Paschur priest. JEREMIAH 20: 7- 13- the inner drama of Jeremiah. JEREMIAH 21: 1-14- the answer to the message of Zedekiah. JEREMIAH 22: 1-20-new threat against the royal dynasty. JEREMIAH 23: 1-9- the bad shepherds and the just king. JEREMIAH 24: 10-40 against the false prophets.

WEDNESDAY OCTOBER 4 PART VII- THE PROPHET JEREMIAH IN JERUSALEM -JEREMIAH 23: 10-40- against the false prophets. JEREMIAH 24: 1-10 -vision of the two baskets of figs. JEREMIAH 25: 1-38 - introduction to the oracles against the nations. JEREMIAH 26: 1-31- arrest of Jeremiah for his speech against the temple. JEREMIAH 26: 24-32- Jeremiah's response to the protest of Shemaiah. JEREMIAH 27: 1-22 -Jeremiah before King Zedekiah.

WEDNESDAY OCTOBER 11-PART VIII - THE PROPHET JEREMIAH IN JERUSALEM - JEREMIAH 36- public reading of the prophecies of Jeremiah (this chapter would come after chapter 3 and 4) JEREMIAH 36: 20-23- King Jehoiakim burns the scroll of Jeremiah. Jeremiah 37: - a new consultation of Zedekiah to Jeremiah. JEREMIAH 38: 1-6-Jeremiah is thrown into a cistern or dry pit. Jeremiah 38 - Jeremiah's last meeting with Zedekiah. JEREMIAH 39- the fall of Jerusalem and the capture of Zedekiah. JEREMIAH 40 - the deliverance of Jeremiah by the Babylonians. JEREMIAH 42 - Gedaliah the governor of Judah, and the murder of Gedaliah. JEREMIAH 44: 1-9 - Jeremiah's Testimony vs. The refugees in Egypt. JEREMIAH 45: 1-5- reproaches and promises from Jeremiah to Baruch. JEREMIAH 52: destruction of Jerusalem

WEDNESDAY OCTOBER 25- PART IX- THE EXILE IN BABYLON - BIBLE PERIOD# 8- JEREMIAH 25: 6-11- Babylon, instrument and object of divine punishment. This chapter is out of order and would come later as an introduction to chapter 46. JEREMIAH 46-51 - the word of IHWG-GOD against the nations: Against Egypt. Against the Philistines. Against Moab. Against Ammon. Against Edom. Prophecies against Babylon

WEDNESDAY NOVEMBER 1- LAMENTACIONES DE JEREMIAS - 1 to 5 (funeral song). Hope in the midst of afflictions.
