Dear Friends,

Today at Mass, before the Gospel acclamation, we will hear the sequence. Most sequence hymns were written in the Middle Ages and were sung just before the Gospel, as the priest processed to the place where the Gospel would be proclaimed. The Pentecost sequence was most likely written by Pope Innocent III (1161-1216). It is widely regarded as one of the masterpieces of sacred Latin Poetry, and is a fitting meditation for our prayer this week.
