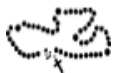

- ◆ **Minister of Holy Communion:** Assist in distributing the Body and Blood of Christ
- ◆ **Lector:** Does the biblical readings and the Prayer of the Faithful
- ◆ **Collectors:** Set up, distribute baskets, and place the collection into the offertory basket that is brought up to the altar
- ◆ **Altar Servers:** Assist the celebrant by lighting candles, leading the procession, holding the Missal, setting up the altar, leading the offertory procession, and clearing the altar

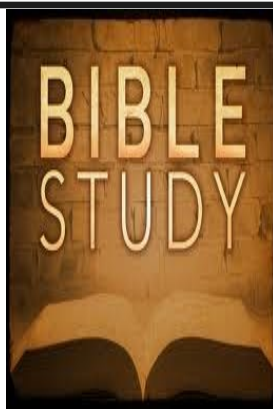

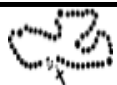
Plan to join us for the 6th Annual Parish Picnic at Camp Morgan.

Dining and restrooms are inside the modern lodge. Swimming, games, play area with swings, volleyball court, baseball field, tether ball, etc. all await.

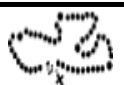
The Social Committee is providing hot dogs, burgers, chicken, corn & beverages. The Knights of Columbus will be grilling.
