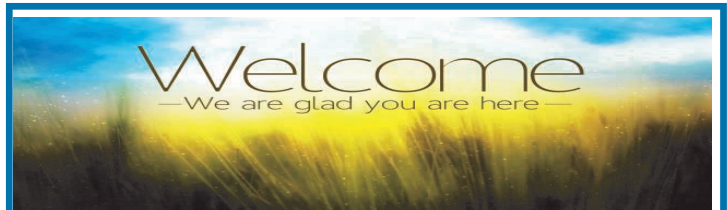

**CEMETERY POLICIES:** St. Anthony's Cemetery has been providing sacred, consecrated ground for burial of parishioners since the mid-1920's. As a parish, we are responsible for the administration and maintenance of the cemetery. When a person "buys" a grave, it is very clear in the deed that a person purchases the "right" to bury a person in a specific grave, but per se the "property" belongs to the diocese (and parish). As such, there are policies created by both the diocese and the parish to maintain the sacredness and order of the cemetery. (Think in terms of an association.) All of this is clearly spelled out in our Cemetery Policies on our parish website as well as in deeds given to those who purchase a grave. The parish has the right (and the responsibility) to update and amend policies for the cemetery. Either because people are unaware, or have chosen to ignore the policies, there have been a number of gravesites that have exceeded the allotted area to place flowers (note, flowers NOT bushes or trees) or other decorations in keeping with the sacredness of a Catholic cemetery. In addition, materials, such as gravel and brick and mortar borders have been used which is damaging our lawn maintenance equipment and potentially causing danger to our workers who use them. Please keep graves confined to the allotted space per grave. Flowers are allowed in the front of the grave and not to exceed 6 inches from the base of the stone. This is to allow lawn equipment adequate space to pass by. Trying to be sensitive to people's desire to honor their loved ones, we need to follow these policies to maintain the beauty and sanctity of our cemetery. Finally, for security reasons, please do not visit the cemetery after sunset.
