- **Youth Ministry Bible Location and time:** Wednesdays, Topside Banquet Room 6:30 am to 7:30 am.

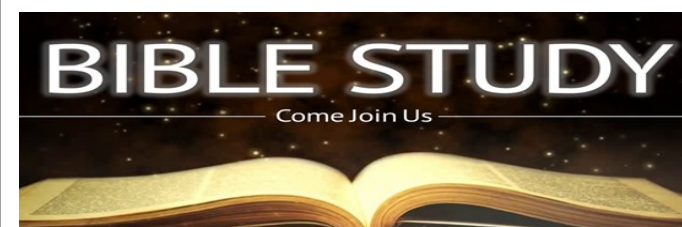

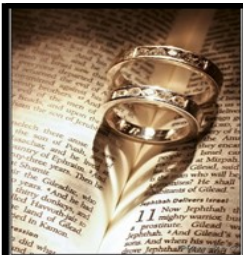
**Eucharistic Minister Meeting**
