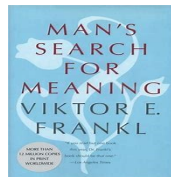

**Part 2 of Fr. Marc's Book-Study Group**

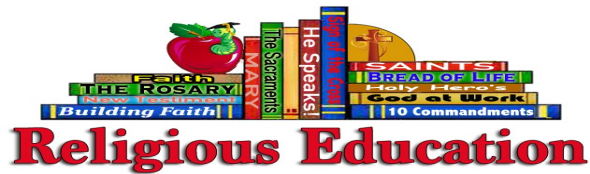
