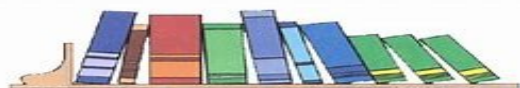

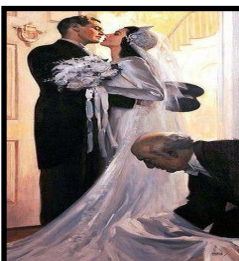
BOOK DISCUSSION GROUP
