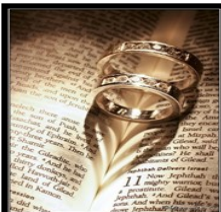

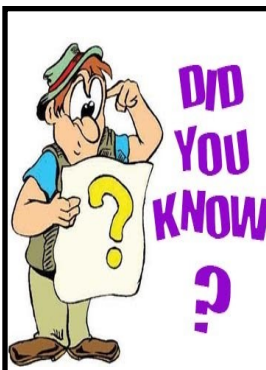
Pilgrimage to Lithuania, Austria, Poland & Italy
