Called To Serve As Christ

Why is the Archdiocese making changes to the priest pension plan funding model? Over the years the Archdiocese has taken many steps to improve the funded status of the pension plan:

- ◆ Increased the amount from the Annual Catholic Appeal to the plans to \$1.6 million per year.
- ◆ Increased billings to the parish contribution of the plan \$600 per year since 2008.
- ◆ Raised the benefit eligibility age from 65 to 70.
- ◆ Full benefit vesting age increased from 25 to 30 years, depending on date of birth.
- ◆ Eliminated three percent extended service benefit.

Despite these efforts, it was not enough to provide a sustainable path for the future. Based on independent actuarial studies, we know if we continue the pay-as-you-go approach, amounts billed to our parishes will continue to increase for the foreseeable future. A much better approach is to properly fund the plans with adequate capital so present and future generations of priests will have a secure retirement plan and the burden on our parishes will be reduced.
