CRS Parish Ambassador Corps

Inspired by Pope Francis, Catholics across the United States are being asked to live their faith in active engagement - to encounter and respond to excluded and suffering people. To help SJB and IC parishioners to answer this call, Catholic Relief Services (CRS) has developed the CRS Parish Ambassador Corps. Each parish in the Archdiocese is asked to recruit two or three parishioners with a heartfelt commitment for the work of CRS to volunteer to represent us.

CRS Parish Ambassadors will be asked to collaborate with parish staff to coordinate three (which is why we need a team of two or three ambassadors) global solidarity initiatives within the pastoral year-September through August—that help their fellow parishioners respond to the Gospel call to care for those in need. Ambassadors make a 2 year commitment to the program. After that, they may renew their commitment annually. Parish Ambassador training will be conducted at the Archdiocese on Saturday, 9/29.
