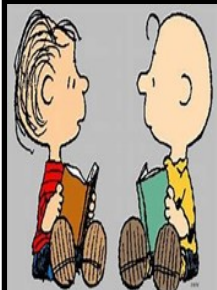

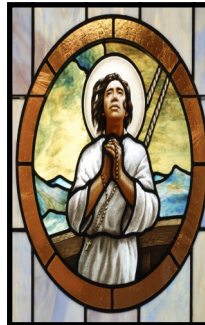


St Vincent de Paul Society
