### SUNDAY READINGS IN A WORD

#### FIRST READING Jeremiah 38:4-6, 8-10

Let us repent of our sin and fix our eyes on the Lord. Jesus gave us an example of endurance and courage in the midst of struggle. In that way he inspires and perfects our faith.

#### GOSPEL READING Luke 12:49-53

Jesus announced to his disciples that he came to bring a hard message indeed, and some have not listened to it. That is why friends and families divide.

### FOCUS

"I have come not to give peace, but discord."  
The presence of God in our lives is an active force rather than a passive one, demanding action on our part. The peace we desire will come through righteousness and justice, not through indifference to others.

### PRAYER CORNER

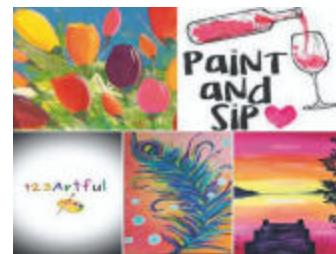

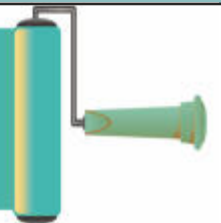
