FROM THE PASTOR

Dear Parishioners:

This Sunday, March 31, is Laetare Sunday. It is taken from Isaiah 66-Reioice. O Jerusalem... Be iovful, all who were in mourning!" Lent is more than half way over. Its counterpart for Advent is Gaudete Sunday (3rd Sunday of Advent) also meaning, 'Rejoice.' This Sunday is marked by a relaxation of the penitential character of the Lenten Season. Flowers may adorn the altar and the organ may be played more fully. Priests will wear Roman Rose Chasubles and deacons will wear Roman Rose Dalmatics. This color is used as a sign of joy. We believe this may stem from the ancient papal tradition of blessing golden roses which would be sent to Catholic heads of state in Europe on the Fourth Sunday of Lent Families can celebrate this day with roses on their tables, to plant a rose bush, or visiting one's 'mother church' where they baptized. (Fr. Ernest, Knights of Columbus). I would invite you all to consider doing something joyful within legal, moral, and ethical means, of course.

We are in the process of putting together a RAGBRAI (Register's Annual Great Bicycle Ride Across Iowa) team for the parish. We will be needing some expertise in emergency planning for weather and other things that may come up unexpectedly, Advertisement, Grounds, Cooking and Clean-up, etc.). I will be contacting individuals face to face to help be a part of this committee. We are expecting over 1000 individuals on our grounds on Tuesday July 23-Wednesday morning July 24th. We will need help planning for many details of this event.

Last, but certainly not least, we have been blessed having Fr. Ron Hodges, a native son of Indianola and a convert to the Catholic Christian faith. He has been ordained 14 years. Fr. Ron has served with the Benedictine Order and is with the Diocese of Davenport, lowa. He is on medical leave until July. Please give him a warm welcome!


