PASTOR REPORT

Dear Parishioners-

I want to thank all of our sacristans and Eucharistic Ministers of Communion. You do a tremendous service to our parishioners behind the scenes before Mass and to the homebound. It is most appreciated! I would like to ask you to please consider removing the key to the tabernacle after Sunday Mass or after taking the hosts from the ciborium in the tabernacle and putting it back in the sacristy. It is my vocation to make sure that Jesus is protected from the potentiality of any type of abuse or unholy use by those who may be less than scrupulous with regards to the Holy Eucharist who may be outside of our parish or who do not fully grasp the meaning of the Real Presence in the Eucharist-that it becomes the body, blood, soul, and divinity after the Institution Narrative of the Eucharistic Prayer ('Take this all of you, eat of it, take this all of you, drink from it). It is no longer bread and wine at this point. Reverence for the Eucharist is in order for all of us who are Catholic Christian. So, thanks for your help and cooperation in this matter. It is most appreciated!

Thanks again to all of our parishioners who worked both RAGBRAI and the Chicken Dinner! Your hours of planning, time, efforts, etc. are most appreciated! We made over \$12,000 for the Chicken Dinner, and just over \$1000 for the RAGBRAI lunch and dinner!
