Some things truly are priceless. You may pay a lot of your hard-earned income to have a home, furnish it for comfort, feed the people who live there, and enjoy the amenities of life. You know the cost of the things you own.

Wondering Why

Luke's Gospel is the only one that tells the story of the two disciples on the Road to Emmaus. Mark mentions briefly an appearance of Jesus to two disciples who were walking on their

way to the country, which is probably the same event, but Mark gives no other details about the encounter other than to say that the two disciples went back and told the others, but were not believed. Luke's account is full of details and gives the story theological depth on a number of levels.

These two disciples are walking *away* from Jerusalem. We can assume they are discouraged and disappointed. Their hopes in Jesus seem to have been crushed three days before when he was put to death. Now they are walking away – away from their hopes, away from their plans, away from their community.

As they walk along a stranger joins them. The reader is told that the stranger is Jesus, but the two disciples do not recognize him. It is a puzzling detail. If they are disciples they must have known Jesus well. One identified as Cleopas may even have been Jesus' uncle, as in another Gospel he is described as being the husband of Mary who was mother of James, a cousin of Jesus. These were close companions, yet they fail to recognize the Lord. Of course, they were not expecting to see Jesus, they did not understand yet about the Resurrection, and even though some women had told them of the empty tomb and stories of angels, these disciples did not believe the women. One could imagine that they were so blinded by the darkness of their own despair that they could not see the Light of their companion.

Jesus knows they do not recognize him, but he chooses not to disclose himself immediately, nor to abandon them for their lack of faith. Instead he begins to explain the scriptures to them and how the writings refer to the Messiah. Even hearing the words of scripture, they don't figure it out, but later they will reflect that their "hearts were burning" as he spoke.

In this story, Luke is telling disciples of all times that Jesus is present with them, even when they are in turmoil and despair and cannot recognize him. Still he is there walking along with them, patiently explaining so that they might understand. And the Lord is present in the scriptures, from the beginning they point the way to him, the promise of God which was a greater promise than could ever have been expected. At the breaking of the bread after the blessing, the disciples recognize that Jesus is with them, but physically he vanishes from their sight. Luke is telling us that it is in the bread that he remains present to his disciples. They do not need his physical body, they have his Eucharistic body, in which he is totally and forever present. Then, these two disciples, who had been discouraged, disbelieving, distressed, know that Jesus lives, and they immediately return to Jerusalem to tell the others.

A description of the Mass is embedded in this early story about the Risen Jesus. He is present when his disciples are gathered. No matter where or under what conditions, he is present in the Word proclaimed, he is present in the breaking of the bread, and all these things call the disciples to mission, to go and tell the others.

We each walk our own Emmaus journey and often fail to recognize that the Lord is walking right beside us all the way. We listen to the scriptures. We share the Eucharistic bread. And we must go back and tell the others of the miracles we experience when we recognize that the stranger who walks with us is the Risen Lord!

Reflexionemos sobre la Palabra de Dios

Algunas veces e inesperadamente algo nuevo se desliza sobre nuestro horizonte y nos agarra desprevenidos. Nos levantamos una mañana, nos quedamos parados al pie de la cama mientras pensamos que es bueno estar vivo; entonces nos sonreímos brevemente antes de volver a concentrarnos en los quehaceres del día. O nos sentamos con un amigo al mediodía para almorzar, nos contamos historias y reímos al recordar cosas de la vida de los dos, y en medio de todo eso pensamos para nosotros mismos que este momento presente ha valido todas las luchas y lágrimas de la vida. O nos sentamos en la rara quietud de una casa donde raramente hay quietud y soñamos despiertos acerca de todas las cosas que han sucedido en esta casa en el transcurso de los días y los años y nos damos cuenta de que dentro de esas paredes además de vida ha habido amor y madurez, y ahora oímos el tirar de una puerta y nuestro día regresa al tumultuoso caos.

Todos esos son momentos de gracia, momentos en que las sombras se esfuman aunque sea brevemente y vemos con mucha más claridad que nunca antes, que ésa es la mera presencia de Dios en que nos movemos y existimos. Entonces, por supuesto, el momento desaparece y queremos contárselo a alguien y tal vez tratemos de hacerlo, pero al final de cuentas nuestras palabras no alcanzan a describir la experiencia. Después de todo, ¿con qué palabras se puede explicar que por un breve momento caminamos por la vida junto a Dios de una manera más consciente que nunca antes?

Me pregunto si eso fue parte de lo que sucedió cuando Cleofás y su amigo se encontraron con el extraño en el camino cuando iban de Jerusalén hacia Emaús. ¿Cómo es posible que no se dieran cuenta que ese extraño era Jesús? Tal vez la gracia haya sido que por la fe llegaron a reconocer al Señor Jesús entre ellos y en realidad no tenía importancia si la luz les llegó rápida o lentamente. Lo importante es que sucedió.
