#### 40Daysfor LIFE - Day 7 intention

The Spirit of the Lord is upon Me, because He has anointed Me to preach the gospel to the poor; He has sent Me to heal the brokenhearted, to proclaim liberty to the captives and recovery of sight to the blind, to set at liberty those who are oppressed.  
— Luke 4:18-19

#### Reflection

This passage is a very familiar one. It has been preached on many occasions, even made popular in books and songs. **Though the quote is about Jesus, all Christians take this commission seriously as a directive on how to reach the world with the gospel.** We, like our Savior, are to bring the good news to the poor, the brokenhearted, those in captivity, those who cannot see, and the oppressed. The commission given to us in this passage is clearly a charge to care for those for whom God cares the most. I wonder though, whom do we look for to be touched by the Holy Spirit as we go out into the world?

**Who are the poor, if not those unborn children who have been abandoned by their parents before they ever leave the womb?**

Who are the brokenhearted, if not those unborn children whose only example of love is having their mother take them to an abortion clinic to be destroyed, or the mother of a child who has been deceived by everyone around her into believing that what she is doing is best for her and her child? Who are the captives, if not those unborn children who are bound over to death by the "choice" of abortion?
