TEXT: Finding God: Our Response to God's Gifts

The Faith of a Fourth Grader: In their faith journey, fourth graders enjoy learning about the heroes of the Bible and the stories of the People of God. They have a strong desire to learn about people, past and present, and their differences. Because they value the attitudes and habits of important adults in their lives, learning about virtues and moral habits is critical at this stage of faith formation. They begin to realize that true happiness comes from knowing and loving God. They develop a deeper appreciation of Scripture, liturgy, community and prayer. You can expect your fourth grader to:

- Enjoy having a role in liturgical experiences and participating in ritual actions
- Delight in retelling and acting out stories from the Bible

- Strive to incorporate good works into daily living
- Like participating in community service
