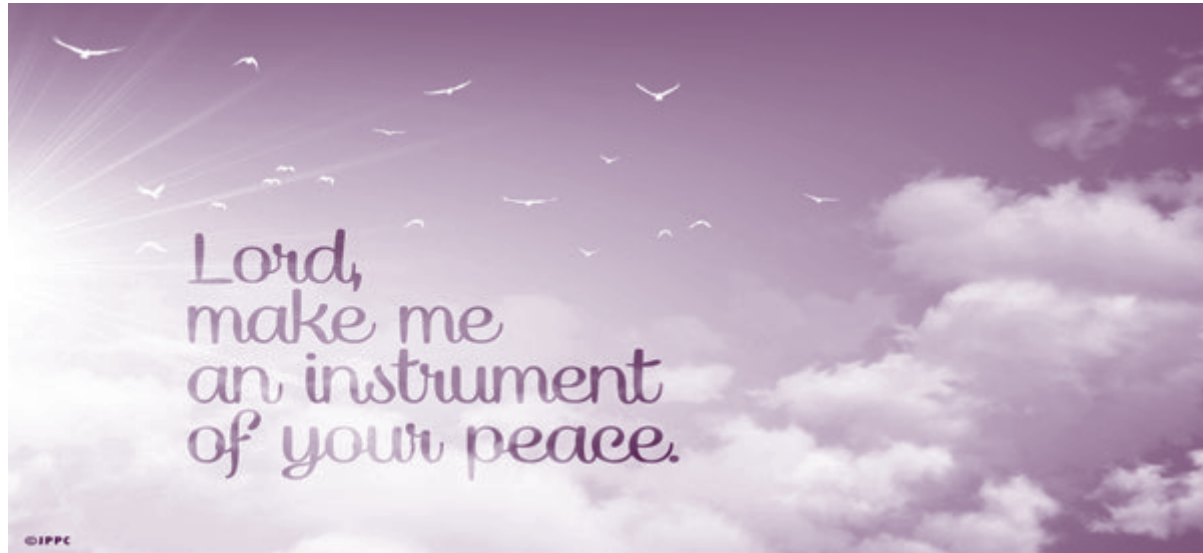

**29TH Sunday in Ordinary Time**

"For the Son of Man did not come to be served, but to serve and to give his life as a ransom for many." (MARK 10:45) If you held a mirror up to your life, would it reflect God's love and mercy? If you are struggling with this, try changing your attitude from "I want more" to "thank you God for everything you have given me, I have enough to share." This change in perspective will bring you joy through service to others.

### **LIFE WITH ONLY ONE ATTACHMENT**

*Jesus has just confronted his disciples with going to Jerusalem and there he will face humiliation, suffering and death. James and John's response is typical of ours as well: "Teacher, we want you to do for us whatever we ask of you." He replies, "what is it you want me to do for you?" And they say to him, "Grant us to sit, one at your right hand and one at your left. Jesus says: "you don't know what you are asking. Are you able to drink the cup that I drink, or be baptized with the baptism that I am baptized with?" They reply, "yes, we are able." But they and the other ten had no clue what they were saying yes to. He spells it out for them and us.*

*Rulers of the world lord it over others, but if you want to be great in the Kingdom of heaven, you must be willing to be the servant of all. In fact you must be the slave of all if you wish to be first. Jesus wanted his disciples and us to realize that in the Kingdom of God, everything is radically different. In the Kingdom, we must become Christ for others. This is not just pious talk. Being and becoming a Christian will demand a whole new way of thinking and acting.*

*Mother Teresa of Calcutta was able to focus on God and was totally in love with Jesus in whatever way he chose to show himself to her. He especially revealed himself in the terrible disguises of the poorest of the poor. As she talked about the judgment scene in the Gospel of Matthew, she says, Christ will not ask us how much we have done, but how much love have we put into our actions.*

*Doing service for others, as Mother Teresa saw it, is not about getting thank you or recognition. It must be born out of an intense love for Jesus and for God. Christ was teaching the apostles and us that it is only by an intense relationship with God that we enter into the Kingdom or realm of God. For the Kingdom of God is not so much a place, but way of being, a way of thinking, and a way of loving one another, a way of humility, a way of total detachment to the things of this world. Gandhi's motto was: "Renounce and enjoy!" (because there is more suffering in self-centeredness than in other-centeredness.)*

*One Catholic writer said: "We will understand the mind of Christ best if, in our own small way we try to live our daily lives with the values Christ lived and died by. When we are filled with Divine Charity, everything becomes secondary. Jesus could easily go without and be detached because he loved much and because his love came from the Father. Christ is attached to only one thing: to do the will of His Father in heaven.*

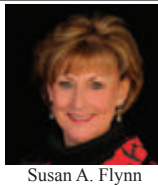
