## A Message from the Pastor

Fourth Sunday in Ordinary Time  
January 31, 2016

Dear parishioners,

We are just a couple of weeks from Ash Wednesday (February 10<sup>th</sup>). Please watch your mailbox for our parish Lenten mailing. Here is a preview of some of our Lenten offerings:

- Our biannual Women’s Cornerstone experience. Did you know that a group of parish women have been meeting since autumn to plan this year’s retreat? They have been sharing faith and planning an amazing experience! I invite all the women of the parish to mark your calendars now – please HOLD March 11-12 for the Cornerstone retreat. You won’t want to miss this chance to meet other parish women and share your journey!
- Our annual Parish Breakfast. Mark your calendars now for that, also! Following the 10 a.m. Mass on Sunday March 13<sup>th</sup> the Youth Ministry sponsors this annual parish social and fund raiser that is a great (and delicious!) time for everyone! Join us in the Auditorium for fellowship and food.
- A new town-wide ecumenical Lenten series! On five consecutive Wednesdays in Lent, different churches will be holding an ecumenical gathering open to all to share together – a Lenten Soup and Study series. A little milestone now arrives: on Monday February 1<sup>st</sup> I officially begin my third term as your Pastor here at Guardian Angel Church. Back in the summer of 2003, while a parochial vicar at Church of the Little Flower in Berkeley Heights, I formally requested to be considered for appointment here when the previous pastor was moving. I was surprised and pleased when Archbishop Myers called to tell me I was being given the assignment! In 2009, I submitted a request to be re-appointed for a second six-year term and Archbishop Myers granted that request also.

You many know that it is generally not customary in the Newark Archdiocese for a pastor to receive a third consecutive term as pastor. But some time ago I had a conversation with co-adjutor Archbishop Hebda about the possibility of my staying here for a third term. A significant factor is that, with the endorsement of the archdiocese and our seminary, I am enrolled in a multi-year program of study toward a doctoral degree in preaching. With that in mind, Archbishop Myers, in consultation with the personnel board, re-appointed me for a third term. I am grateful to God every day for the call to serve the Lord and the Church as a priest, and for the opportunity to live among you and share a journey of faith together in my service to you as your shepherd in Christ.

## MARDI GRAS BRUNCH AND ASH WEDNESDAY AT GUARDIAN ANGEL

Many Christians mark the beginning of the Season of Lent through the observation of **Ash Wednesday, this year on February 10**. While not a Holy Day of Obligation for Roman Catholics, it is a day that many attend Church services in order to begin a season of penance as they are marked with ashes. We may be told “*Repent, believe in the Gospel,*” or “*Remember that you are dust, and to dust you shall return.*” These two formulas are somber in tone. One reminds us of the penitential nature of Lent; the other reminds us of the brevity of life. Both should lead us in the same direction: conversion towards Christ now!

**At Church of the Guardian Angel ashes will be distributed during the following liturgies in our Church: 9 a.m. (Mass), 12:15 p.m. (Liturgy of the Word), 3:45 p.m. (Liturgy of the Word), and 8 p.m. (Mass).**

### YEAR OF MERCY REFLECTION

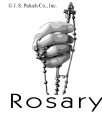

### Center For Food Action Needs

The Center for Food Action in Mahwah provides 85 families each week a month's worth of groceries, thus serving approximately 340 families on a monthly basis. The Center has identified **Rolls of Paper Towels and Rolls of Toilet Paper as needed items for the month of February**. This month our goal is to collect 85 boxes of instant mashed potatoes and 85 cans of Potatoes each week to support the number of families the CFA serves on a weekly basis. # YOUTH MINISTRY

## Mini Family Bible Study

Reading: 1 Corinthians 13:4-7, 13

**Read through the complete passage to start then go through the verses asking questions such as:**

**v. 4-7** "Love is patient, love is kind. It is not jealous, it is not pompous, it is not inflated, it is not rude, it does not seek its own interests, it is not quick-tempered, it does not brood over injury, it does not rejoice over wrongdoing but rejoices with the truth. It bears all things, believes all things, hopes all things, endures all things."

**Questions:** If God is love then what can we learn about God from this passage? How does this description of God compare to how you see Him? Which word or phrase in this description stands out the most? What does it mean that God bears all things? How does the way that you personally love God, yourself and others compare to the true definition of love? Which defining area of love do you desire to grow in the most? What are some ways we can practice this kind of love on a daily basis?

**v. 8 & 13** "Love never fails. If there are prophecies, they will be brought to nothing; if tongues, they will cease; if knowledge, it will be brought to nothing. So faith, hope, love remain, these three; but the greatest of these is love. So faith, hope, love remain, these three; but the greatest of these is love."

**Questions:** What makes love so powerful that it will never fail? Why is it that great things are brought to nothing without love? How does love empower us to have even greater faith and hope? Looking at our own motives and intentions do we back up every action with love? How can we get in the habit of checking our intentions before we act to ensure that all that we do is coming from a place of love?

# RELIGIOUS EDUCATION

Religious Ed registration for the 2016 - 2017 school year is ongoing in the rectory during the regular Religious Ed office hours of Monday to Thursday 10:30 AM to 3:00 PM. On Tuesdays during January, we will be in the rectory from 7:30 PM until 9:00 PM for those who cannot make it during the day. All families are encouraged to register at this time. If you would like your family to participate in Summer Angel Wings, you must register by Tuesday February 23<sup>rd</sup>.

As of now the dates for Summer Angel Wings are June 24, 27, 28, 29, 30, July 1, 6, 7 & 8, 2016. The hours are 9:00 AM to 12:30 PM. Summer Angel Wings is open to all children who will be in grades 1 – 5 in September 2016.

The fee for all programs is:

\$175 for one child, \$225 for two children and \$275 for three or more children.

Additional fees are:

Next Sunday, February 7<sup>th</sup> the 8<sup>th</sup> graders will participate in a retreat morning. The retreat will begin at 8:45 AM in the auditorium and conclude with 11:30 Youth Mass in the church. A light breakfast will be served. Parents of 8<sup>th</sup> grade parents will meet in the barn from 8:45 until 9:30 for a meeting to go over the Confirmation program which begins in September of 9<sup>th</sup> grade with a weekend retreat on the weekend of September 16<sup>th</sup> to 18<sup>th</sup>.

Every year the Archdiocese of Newark asks that all fifth and eighth grade Religious Education Programs participate in the Assessment of Catechesis/Religious Education (ACRE). This program assessment for catechesis/religious education has been developed by the National Catholic Education Association to:

- Serve as a tool for assessing the effectiveness of catechetical/religious education programs;
- Offer a picture of where grade 5 & 8 students are in terms of their basic religious knowledge;
- Assess the religious beliefs, attitudes, practices, and perceptions of students in these grades in addition to their religious knowledge; and,
- Provide information about areas of strengths in catechetical/religious education programs as well as areas that may need additional attention or improvement.

This assessment will be administered to your fifth and eighth graders on Tuesday February 9, 2016. **Fifth grade students will take the assessment from 3:30 until 4:30 on February 9<sup>th</sup> in the barn. The eighth graders are asked to report to the auditorium from 7:30 until 8:30 PM for the administration of this assessment.** Please make sure that your children understand that this is not for a grade, but rather to see how well Guardian Angel is teaching Religious Education. We have done our best to see that the children are not stressed over this. Please do your best to have your child at Religious Education class promptly on February 9<sup>th</sup> so that we may begin the assessment on time and complete it in the limited time that we have.
