## A Message from the Pastor

*Solemnity of Our Lord Jesus Christ,  
King of the Universe  
November 20, 2016*

Dear parishioners,

I saw in the news that as the special “Jubilee Year of Mercy” ends, Pope Francis celebrated Mass in St. Peter’s Basilica last Sunday with 6,000 homeless and impoverished persons. He is quoted as saying: “Almost everything in this world is passing away, like running water. What endures, what has value in life, what riches do not disappear? Surely these two: the Lord and our neighbor. These are the greatest goods; these are to be loved. Everything else – the heavens, the earth, all that is most beautiful, even this Basilica – will pass away; but we must never exclude God or others from our lives.”

The Pope added: “When we speak of exclusion, we immediately think of concrete people, not useless objects but precious persons. The human person, set by God at the pinnacle of creation, is often discarded, set aside in favor of ephemeral things. This is unacceptable, because in God’s eyes man is the most precious good. It is ominous that we are growing used to this rejection. We should be worried when our consciences are anaesthetized and we no longer see the brother or sister suffering at our side, or notice the grave problems in our world ...”

Right here in Allendale, NJ it is certainly a risk in our wealthy community that we could become blind or “anaesthetized” to the severe challenges so many people face.

According to the Family Promise network, which reaches out to help homeless families, right here in Bergen County at least 339 school-aged children were identified as being homeless last year. When a family with no income becomes homeless, they are eligible for temporary rental assistance. But when a family with some income, but not enough to afford housing, becomes homeless, then that family does not qualify for assistance.

Family Promise is the only organization in Bergen County that provides shelter and support to homeless working families with children. Guardian Angel parish, and the other Christian communities of Allendale, work together locally with the Family Promise organization. We provide overnight shelter for a week several times a year, including a couple of weeks in our own Auditorium. **THIS WEEK IS ONE OF THOSE WEEKS.** Think about the reality of it – families in our own area homeless during Thanksgiving week!

Family Promise offers support – job training, education, childcare, transportation and more – so that families have the resources to compete for jobs that earn a living wage. Besides our ministry of service – providing a place, meals and overnight host volunteers, you can support Family Promise financially. Donations may be sent to: Family Promise of Bergen County, 100 Dayton St, Ridgewood, NJ 07450. Your support makes a real difference for the families we serve and helps provide for:

- Beds for children in the sheltering program
- Rent for a transitional apartment for a family
- Financial literacy and empowerment workshops so parents can improve life skills

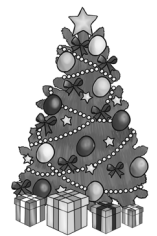
### **'Tis the season!**

## OUR TOWN AT DON BOSCO PREP

Come out to enjoy Don Bosco Prep's production of Thornton Wilder's Pulitzer Prize winning drama, *Our Town*, the story of the small fictional New Hampshire town of Grovers' Corners, and what happened there between 1901 and 1913. Thornton Wilder was awarded the Pulitzer Prize in 1938 for the play, which was lauded for its minimalism and for the town's representation of any town in the world. Broadway actor, singer and Don Bosco Prep Alumnus, Matt Ban, Class of 2005, who is directing the Don Bosco production of *Our Town*, described it as a play, "that was the first of its kind in that by virtue of its minimalism, it broke down typical conceptions of theater. It had no sets, no props. *Our Town* is more about the words and the actions of the actors. This play strips everything away." The story line of *Our Town*, which is about the cycle of life, was called by *New York Times* Theater Critic, Brooks Atkinson, "one of the finest achievements of the current stage... a hauntingly beautiful play," during its Broadway run at the Henry Miller Theater in 1938. The universal theme of caring and helping one another, our families, friends and neighbors, is the premise upon which this story is based.
