A Message from the Pastor

May 21, 2017
Sixth Sunday of Easter

Dear parishioners,
This weekend 40 of our young people will receive the Sacrament of Confirmation here at Guardian Angel parish. We welcome Bishop John Flesey to bestow the Sacrament on Sunday at 2 p.m.

I have enjoyed seeing our candidates serve the church through ministry and service, and participating with them on their parish Confirmation weekend retreat last autumn. I'm grateful to our Youth Minister Katie Cavazzini, to those who have been assisting with the Confirmation preparation process, and to those who assisted as retreat chaperones. Of course the primary responsibility for faith formation of children and teens is with their parents, who promised at their child's baptism to raise them in the practice of the faith. All that we as a parish staff and volunteers do is meant to be in support of that primary mission the parents have, assisted by godparents.

One final requirement for the sacrament is for the candidate to write me a letter requesting to be confirmed, explaining why they desire the sacrament and how they know they are ready. Often the letters go beyond basic requests to share special and personal details about what Jesus, the Catholic faith, Guardian Angel parish, and our Confirmation preparation process mean to them. As is my tradition, I'd like to share (anonymously) a few of their thoughts from just a sampling of the letters, so that you too might be encouraged in the ways the Holy Spirit is working among and around us!

I feel that this year I really grew in my faith and truly began to understand the values of the church.

I began to realize that it was more than just going to class. Each week I was developing my relationship with God.

It is important to me to have my faith and share it with others.

Recently I have struggled with my faith, but I have also made it stronger. I want to thank everyone who has guided me through this journey.

I always knew that I would receive my Confirmation ... what I didn't expect was WANTING to make my Confirmation.

My hope is to fulfill God's purpose for me and use my strengths to help others.

I want to help out the Church in the future and help others turn to God and Jesus.

This year I have learned a lot in all of my CCD classes and it makes me want to receive Confirmation more and more so I can become a better Roman Catholic and a better person in general.

I want to continue being a part of the Youth Group and grow with the Church.

My sponsor has been a religious mentor and role model to me during this process.

I have learned that I truly believe in the Nicene Creed. I learned to live my faith through service, Mass and talking about God.

The Archdiocese of Newark welcomed 499 catechumens and 693 candidates at the Easter Vigil on April 15.



Catechumens receive the sacraments of initiation - baptism, confirmation and first Communion - during the Easter Vigil, having prepared for this moment through the Rite of Christian Initiation of Adults. Candidates, who are already baptized, also go through the preparation program to receive confirmation and first Communion to enter full communion with the church.

The Parish Renewal Fund, established by the **We Are Living Stones Capital Campaign**, will enable parishes to apply for grants to enhance their evangelization efforts as well as religious education programs. This will allow the Church of Newark to continue to spread the Gospel and proclaim Jesus Christ as our Risen Savior.

On May 27, seven men will be ordained as priests at the Cathedral Basilica of the Sacred Heart in Newark.

Five of the men are resident seminarians of Immaculate Conception Seminary; one is a resident seminarian of Redemptoris Mater; and one studied at the Pontifical North American College in Rome.



Rev. Mr. Philip Micele said, "I am deeply grateful for all the support, both financial and spiritual, which the people of the Archdiocese of Newark have provided us. Their contributions enable us to have access to excellent professors and formators who help us to grow as men of prayer, and come to know and love the Lord and his church more deeply. During my years as a seminarian, I can say I've experienced a lot of personal growth, and so much of that is due to the generosity of the people of the Archdiocese of Newark."
