## A Message from the Pastor

May 20, 2018  
Pentecost Sunday

Dear parishioners,

This weekend we observe Pentecost, which is the joyful conclusion of the season of Easter. Pentecost celebrates the incredible abundance of God's bestowal of the many gifts of the Holy Spirit. We are all called to be open to receiving those gifts and selflessly sharing them for the benefit of the whole Church.

We first receive the blessings of the Holy Spirit at our Baptism, but we are immersed more deeply in the power of the Holy Spirit in the Sacrament of Confirmation. This weekend 37 of our young people were confirmed here at Guardian Angel parish. We welcomed Newark Archdiocese Auxiliary Bishop Manuel Cruz, who bestowed the Sacrament.

One final requirement to demonstrate readiness for the sacrament is for the candidate to write me a letter requesting to be confirmed, and explaining why. The letters are touching, as many of them share special and personal details about the impact on their lives by Jesus, the Catholic faith, Guardian Angel parish, their catechists, sponsors and families and our Confirmation preparation program. As is my tradition, I'd like to share (anonymously) some of their thoughts from just a sampling of the letters, so that you too might be encouraged in the ways the Holy Spirit is working among and around us!

*It is very important to receive the sacrament to be closer to God and all of the things he puts in your life.*

*I take my faith very seriously and promise to strive to lead the way of life that Jesus has intended me to live.*

*I have started praying a lot more.*

*I have chosen to be part of the mission of Christ.*

*The encouragement from everyone around me has made my motivation to complete this sacrament even greater.*

*I appreciate all that our youth ministry leaders and my family has done to support me along the way.*

*I want to be a Catholic because I choose to be a Catholic.*

*Staying a part of the Church and staying close to God is important to me. Staying close to God is important to me because I need him by my side to help me out when I'm facing tough times.*

*I feel that I have been well prepared for Confirmation through all of the classes, faith sharing, service projects, retreats, large group sessions, small group sessions and Masses I have attended.*

*It is fun to help the younger children and also help with events like the carnival, food bank and parish activities.*

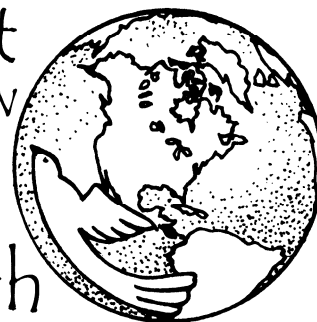
