## A Message from the Pastor

October 28, 2018  
Thirtieth Sunday in Ordinary Time

Dear parishioners,

This weekend at our 11:30 a.m. Sunday Mass we have our annual “Remembrance Mass,” during which we will pray by name for parishioner family members who have died in the past year. We’re grateful to the parish ministry team who organizes the prayerful tribute and prepares the family brunch that follows.

Our parish also celebrates a novena of Masses with the special intention of “All Souls.” These regularly scheduled Masses begin with the 9 a.m. weekday Mass on Friday November 2 (the memorial of The Commemoration of All The Faithful Departed). The Masses are offered for those for whom you have asked prayers with the notes accompanying your All Souls envelope offerings.

This commemoration reminds us of the great spiritual work of mercy of comforting the sorrowful. It is a beautiful dimension of Christian care to attend the wake service – both to comfort the bereaved and to pray for the deceased. It is also a good and worthy thing for each person to attend a funeral Mass – which is not meant to be private for immediate family alone. Sometimes our presence is a comfort to people we know; sometimes it is a consolation to those we do not know, but who feared that perhaps nobody would come for their loved one’s funeral. And it is always a good and worthy thing to pray for the souls of the faithful departed – in God’s providential plan, our prayers assist them toward heaven.

Each week at the end of Mass you hear an announcement about particular needs for the “Center for Food Action.” The regional location is in Mahwah, which serves northwest Bergen County. There are many families and individuals in our midst who are in need; the Center seeks to help them. We help them through our weekly donation of non-perishable food. This month they specifically request cans of “hearty soup.”

Feeding the hungry is not just a “nice” or “noble” *extra* thing to do – it is an essential part of our Christian calling. Pope Francis has said: “Among the corporal works of mercy, the first is that of feeding the hungry. Access to food and water is a basic human right, yet so many members of our human family, especially children, continue to suffer from hunger and thirst. While grateful for the generosity and solidarity shown in the case of many tragic situations worldwide, we must never forget that this work of mercy calls us to respond personally to concrete situations of need in our own lives. Saint James warns against ignoring the practical needs of our brothers and sisters, for faith without works is dead (James 2:14-17).”

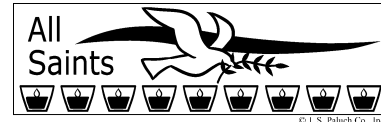

## **MAN OF MANY TALENTS**

When you think of Jesus, what do you think was his job? Healer of the sick, the lame and the blind, as in today's gospel? The second reading from Hebrews reminds us of his main duty: It calls him a High Priest. He would offer the most important sacrifices and so appeal to God for forgiveness of the peoples' sins.

The high priest offered sacrifice for his own sins, as well as the peoples'. While Jesus did not sin, he experienced temptations just as we do and so can intercede for us as one who knows what it is like to be tempted. If you ever wonder if you deserve to be forgiven, remember that Jesus died for all sinners, deserving or not. Like the high priest, Jesus also brings our prayers to his Father and shows us the Father's love.

Our baptism gives us a share in that priesthood. You don't have to be ordained to pray for your friends and family. When you listen to a friend who is hurting, or forgive someone who hurts you, you are blessing them with God's love. When you encourage them to have faith and trust in the Lord, you are bringing them to God. You are sharing in the priesthood of Christ.

## KILLING THE PAIN, NOT THE PATIENT: PALLIATIVE CARE VS. ASSISTED SUICIDE

Assisted suicide is in the news and on lawmakers' agendas. Supporters call it "aid in dying" & claim it's just another option for end-of-life care. But it's radically different from the practice of palliative care, the healing art of relieving pain and other distressing symptoms for patients who are seriously ill.

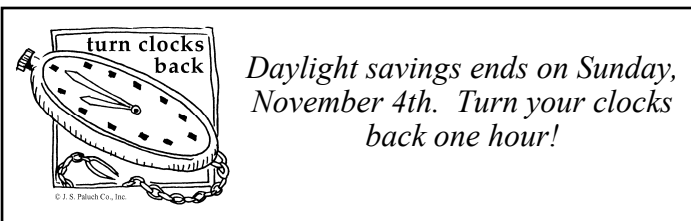
Did you know?

*Medical organizations like the American Medical Association oppose assisted suicide.*

Palliative care intends to comfort a patient, addressing physical, psychological, emotional, and spiritual needs. Assisted suicide, by contrast, directly intends the patient's death. It ignores any underlying problems, and instead abandons and eliminates the patient who has the problems.

As a society and as individuals, we must dedicate ourselves to providing genuinely compassionate care that protects God's gift of life.
