Permanent Diaconate Formation Program

A permanent deacon is a man of faith and love. As an ordained minister of the Catholic Church, he strives to extend that faith and love by serving the sick, the lonely, the troubled and the poor by proclaiming the Word of God, and by administering His Sacraments. As the Greek word "*diakonos*" suggests, a deacon is a servant, assisting in the work of bringing God to His people and of reconciling His people to God through the proclamation of the Word, celebration of the Sacraments and service to others.

The deacon has a unique calling and his response to that call acknowledges God's special design in his life and, indeed, in the life of his family if he is a husband and father. The call is not away from the world but rather into it.

Diocesan Honor

The VIVERE CHRISTUS EST Medal
"FOR TO ME, LIVING IS CHRIST . . ." (Philippians 1:21)

In April, 2009, our Bishop the Most Reverend Arthur J. Serratelli instituted a Diocesan honor called the VIVERE CHRISTUS EST Medal—"FOR TO ME, LIVING IS CHRIST." In the Bishop's words, "St. Paul's message for to me living is Christ, Philippians 1:21, conveys an attitude of sacrifice and humble service to be lived by all and proclaiming the Gospel. Essential to the work of the Church, are the many dedicated men and women of the Diocese of Paterson who continually live as faithful stewards of God's grace and generosity. I am happy to announce that I have created a Diocesan honor to recognize the contributions of the faithful to the mission of Christ and his Church . . . to express gratitude and appreciation to love who unselfishly give of their time, talent, and treasure for the building up of God's kingdom. The VIVERE CHRISTUS EST Medal, accompanied by a personalized Scroll of Recognition will be presented to those chosen for this honor."

The recipient of the Diocesan Honor for St. Pius X Parish in Montville is Joseph P. O'Dowd. Excerpts from the texts that accompanied the recommendation for Joe are as follows:

Joe has been an active parishioner of St. Pius X for many years in many different ministries. He has been a Eucharistic Minister for 30 years, taught Religious Formation for 27 years and was a Pre-Cana Team Leader with his wife, Pat, for 21 years. Joe has been a generous steward of the faith volunteering as a worker on the Parish Center and Ministry House Campaigns, Chairman of the Partners In Faith Campaign and a member of the Finance Committee and Parish Council for many years. In the community, Joe is one of the founders of the Montville Food Pantry and is a Court Appointed Special Advocate for children in the custody of DYFS. Joe is a daily communicant who is prayerful, generous and deserving of the Vivere Christus Award.

With great joy we celebrate the bestowing of this Diocesan Honor to Joseph P. O'Dowd. The presentation will be awarded at Vespers on Sunday, June 14th, at 3:30 pm at St. Philip The Apostle Church, Clifton. Family, friends and all parishioners are invited to the presentation and a small reception following the prayer service.
