- 5. Grease Trap-Parish Center \$ 5,619.20

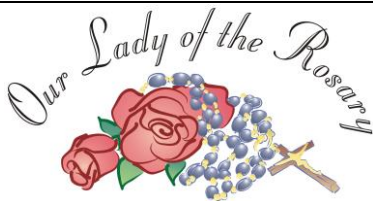

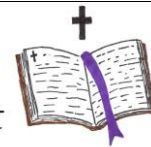
