Forgiveness Is A Gift For You

Right or wrong, when we hold onto an injury, we get trapped in the pain of it indefinitely. Forgiving frees us to move on. Forgiveness is something we do for ourselves.

Start with a sign. Even if you are the one injured, let the other person know you are ready to forgive by offering something tangible: flowers, a card, a hug. *“Come now, let us set things right, says the Lord” (Isaiah 1:18).*

Separate the offense from the offender. God doesn't abandon us when we sin. He loves us no matter what and asks that we do the same for each other.

Forgive and forget. You can't have one without the other. Forgiveness entails cancelling a debt, whether by God or another person. *“Love does not brood over injury, it does not rejoice over wrongdoing but rejoices with the truth. It bears all things, believes all things, hopes all things, endures all things . . .” (1 Corinthians 12:5-8).*

Celebrate. A mended relationships is stronger than one that has never been tested.
