### The Voice Of Promise

After experiencing several major storms that caused power outages lasting for days, we installed a gas generator in the rectory. It would enable our staff to address critical needs of the community in a prolonged power loss. Every Wednesday at 1 pm, the generator turns on for 10 minutes to test that it is working. The first few times this happened the loud noise startled me. Now, accustomed to the weekly noise, it has become a sound that promises help and security in the event of trouble.

The voice of John the Baptist seemed like noise to those who had become complacent in living their faith. His words condemned their indifference to the needs of the community. But for those who were living as God's children, his voice became the promise of help and security. God would come as the One who would stand with the poor and forgotten of the world. Jesus would bring a grace to those who found themselves powerless in the storms of life.

The lights and sounds of this time of year can distract us from the meaning of Advent. To many of us, the voice of the Baptist is a call to turn from the darkness and toward the light of Jesus. For all of us, it is the promise that Jesus stands with us wherever we are powerless.
