SECOND SUNDAY IN ORDINARY TIME

First Reading: Isaiah 62:1-5

Second Reading: I Corinthians 12:4-11

Gospel: John 2:1-11

Jesus and Mary attended a wedding where Mary informed Jesus that there was no more wine. At first he said it did not concern him, but then he turned several jugs of water into wine.
