Dear Father Madden and Christ the King Parish,

In 1993, our family, the Flys, came to Callaway Gardens for the first time as a group of 20. We returned in 1997 and came every year through 2008. During that time our number grew to 24 and at times, extended family joined in, bringing our number to 40. We returned in 2014 and again this year. The youngest grandchild who originally came as a 6 month old is now 21 and 3 great-grandchildren have been added to the mix.

One thing that we all look forward to each year was attending Mass at Christ the King. We were with you in your tiny church and bought many a raffle ticket as you went through your capital campaign for the new church – unfortunately, none of us went home with a new truck. Father Madden always made us feel welcome. We are in awe of your church and were sad to hear that it had been damaged.

We attended Mass on July 13 this year and had called ahead to ask for a special blessing upon Ron and Annette who were celebrating their 40th wedding anniversary. When we arrived, we were greeted warmly and you had even reserved several rows for us. Needless to say, the kindness that was shown to all of us was greatly appreciated and made our visit even more special.

Two of my sister-in-laws and myself, were not Catholic when we came to Callaway for the first time. Over the years, we have all converted and I know that for myself the love and acceptance at Christ the King was a wonderful example of the Catholic faith. Peg passed away in 2005, but her quiet strength, faith in Christ and family was an example to us all. Her legacy of gathering at Callaway continues. I would never have imagined that 1 week a year could grow and solidify the family bonds as it has done with all of us. Christ the King holds a special place in our hearts and I wanted to thank you and your parish for adding to our memories and being Christ to us through your love and hospitality.
