FEAST OF OUR LADY OF THE ROSARY:

October 7, 1571— The Turkish Ottoman Empire had invaded and occupied the Byzantine world for over a hundred years, imposing Islamic law onto all those it conquered. Taking advantage of an increasingly-divided Christian world, the Turks moved westward by land and sea. Three Catholic powers on the continent — Genoa, Spain, and the Papal States — formed the Holy League alliance and sailed their fleets to confront the Turks near the west coast of Greece. Crew members on more than 200 ships prayed the Rosary in preparation for the battle — as did Christians throughout Europe, encouraged by Pope Pius V to gather in their churches to invoke the Virgin Mary against the daunting Turkish forces. By invocation and intercession of the Blessed Virgin Mary, all but 13 of the nearly 300 Turkish ships were sunk or captured. The most significant weapon of the Holy League was the Holy Rosary. Our Lady of the Rosary, intercede for us!
