SAINTS OF THE DAY

SAINTS SIMON AND JUDE, October 28— Apostles of Jesus Christ who were both martyred for their faith.

Saint Simon—Also known as Simon the Zealot, was a Christian convert like the other apostles. Trained by Saint Peter the Apostle, is represented in art with a saw, the instrument of his martyrdom. He is the patron saint of sawmen, woodcutters, and tanners.

Saint Jude—Also known as Judas Thaddeus, was confused by early Christians with the traitor Judas Iscariot; thus, devotion to Saint Jude became something of a lost cause. Patron saint of desperate situations, forgotten, impossible, or lost causes.
