**SAINT OF THE DAY**

**SAINT MARTIN OF TOURS, November 11**— Born in Pannonia (Hungary) and raised in paganism, he was required to follow his father into the cavalry corps of the Roman military where he served until the age of twenty. From an early age, Martin felt drawn to the Christian faith despite his upbringing. During a winter tour in Amiens, he encountered a beggar who was unclothed, and, having not a penny to give him, Martin removed his cloak, cut it in half, and gave one part to the beggar leaving a remnant for himself. After his release from military service, Martin succeeded in converting many to Christianity, founded the first monastery in Gaul, destroyed many pagan temples and groves, and evangelized through all the provinces he traveled. He was made Bishop of Tours and is the patron of the poor, beggars, soldiers, wool-weavers and tailors.
