The **second book** is the student's choice from the list of **suggested books**. At the beginning of the year, we will review the required book and students will take a test at the end of the review. There is no project for the required reading; however, each student will complete a collage project for the second book they choose. Students will present their completed project to the class. **Projects are due by August 30, 2019.**

Choose one of the suggested books and complete the collage project.

4th Grade Collage Project

- You will create a collage about the book you read on a sheet of **construction paper** (8.5 x 11 in. or 9 x 12 in.).
- The front of your collage must contain the **title of the book** and the **author**.
- Find words and pictures from old magazines or catalogues that represent the book you read.
- You must have **at least 10 pictures** on your collage.
- On the back of your collage, you will write a **summary** of your book. You may use lined paper to write your summary and attach it to the back of the collage. Summaries should be written in your best **cursive handwriting**.
- You will present your collage to the class. Be prepared to explain the images and words you chose to represent your book.
- Don't forget to put your **name** on your project.
