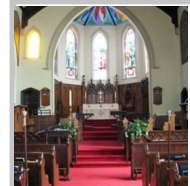

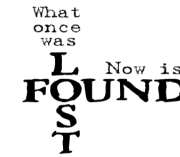

**THE READINGS**

**Reading I - Samuel 1: 20-22, 24-28** The lovely story of Hannah and Samuel is an example of the goal of parenting - to give your children back to God, Samuel, at the correct age, was presented to the Temple and remained there under the supervision of Eli.
