## FROM THE PASTOR

Monday is the day! Deacon Francisco will be ordained a priest for the Diocese of Charleston here in our parish church. The Mass begins at 6 p.m. on Monday, February 11th. All are invited to attend. Fair warning: it's apt to be quite crowded -- you may want to arrive early.

If you've never been to the ordination of a priest before, it is well worth your time to attend. It is a beautiful, and somewhat long, ritual. It will take place in the middle of Mass, between the homily and the offertory. As he is ordained in the midst of Mass, Francisco will then concelebrate the Sacrifice along with the Bishop and the other priests who will be present.

We've been working on an extensive program to help you follow along and understand everything that will happen during the ordination. I think that a couple of traditions, however, are well worth mentioning. During the ordination, the Bishop will "smear" Francisco's hands with sacred Chrism (the same oil used at Baptism and Confirmation -- a reminder, among other things, of the indelible marks these Sacraments impart to the soul). After that, Francisco will be conducted briefly to the sacristy to wipe the chrism from his hands with a special cloth (called a *maniturgia*). After the Mass is concluded, Francisco will present this cloth to his mother. Upon her death, the *maniturgia* will be wrapped around her hands for her burial. As for his father, the purple stole Francisco uses when he hears his first confession will be presented to his father. These ancient customs are not part of the Rite of Ordination *per se*, but they are reminders to parents of the great blessing of raising up a priest of Jesus Christ.

Of course, February 11th is also our parish Feast Day: the feast of Our Lady of Lourdes. It was on February 11th, 1858, that the Blessed Virgin Mary appeared for the first time to the 14-year-old peasant girl, Bernadette Soubirous. If you've never seen the 1943 motion picture, *The Song of Bernadette*, it's well worth watching. Interestingly, Jennifer Jones, the actress who portrayed Bernadette in the film, won the Oscar for Best Actress in a leading role for her work in the movie. The film also won Oscars for Best Art Direction, Best Cinematography, and Best Musical Score. At the very first Golden Globe awards in 1944, *The Song of Bernadette* won Best Motion Picture (drama), Best Director, and Best Actress again for Jennifer Jones. Quite a difference from the Hollywood of our times.
