## FROM THE PASTOR

Lent is upon us! This coming Wednesday, March 6th, is Ash Wednesday. The schedule for that day is as follows: 7:15 a.m. Liturgy of the Word with distribution of ashes -- this is a very short service, especially for those who might want to get their ashes before heading to work or school; 12:05 p.m. Mass in English with distribution of ashes -- for those who might want to get ashes on their lunch break; and 6:30 p.m. Mass (bi-lingual) with distribution of ashes.

Please remember that Ash Wednesday is a day of **FAST** and **ABSTINENCE** from meat. The rule of the fast is that one full meal may be eaten, plus two additional smaller meals that together do not equal the one full meal (the easiest way to think of it is this: one meal and two snacks during the course of the day). The fast is obligatory for everyone from age 18 to age 59. It does not apply to those who may be sick, hospitalized, etc. Abstinence from meat applies to everyone from age 14 onward.

All of the Fridays during Lent are days of abstinence from meat.

During the season of Lent many people like to give up something as a means of disciplining themselves and their appetites. What you may not know, however, is that this practice carries with it a partial indulgence: "A partial indulgence is granted to the Christian faithful who, in a spirit of penance, voluntarily abstain from something that is licit for and pleasing to them." (from the *Manual of Indulgences*.) That's knocking time off Purgatory!

The pious exercise of the Way of the Cross carries with it a Plenary Indulgence (which may be applied either to oneself or to a deceased person). In addition to the exercise of the Way of the Cross, the general conditions for a Plenary Indulgence must also be satisfied. These are as follows: 1) freedom from attachment to sin; 2) sacramental confession; 3) reception of Holy Communion; and 4) prayer for the intentions of the Pope (which is satisfied by reciting one Our Father and one Hail Mary).

To that end, we're going to try something a little different this year with our Stations of the Cross -- we're going to have them on Thursday evenings immediately following the 5:30 p.m. Mass. So, one could go to Mass at 5:30, receive Holy Communion, attend Stations, say an Our Father and a Hail Mary for the Pope's prayer intentions and get a Plenary Indulgence! Regarding Confession, going on the preceding or following Saturday suffices. In fact, because one confession can apply to more than one indulgence, one could go on a Saturday and satisfy that requirement for the indulgence for the Stations on both the preceding and the following Thursdays. *The first Stations of the Cross will be Thursday, March 14th, following the 5:30 p.m. Mass.*

**Finally, a reminder that Daylight Saving Time resumes next Sunday, March 10th (the First Sunday of Lent). Remember to set your clocks ahead one hour before going to bed on Saturday, March 9th.**
