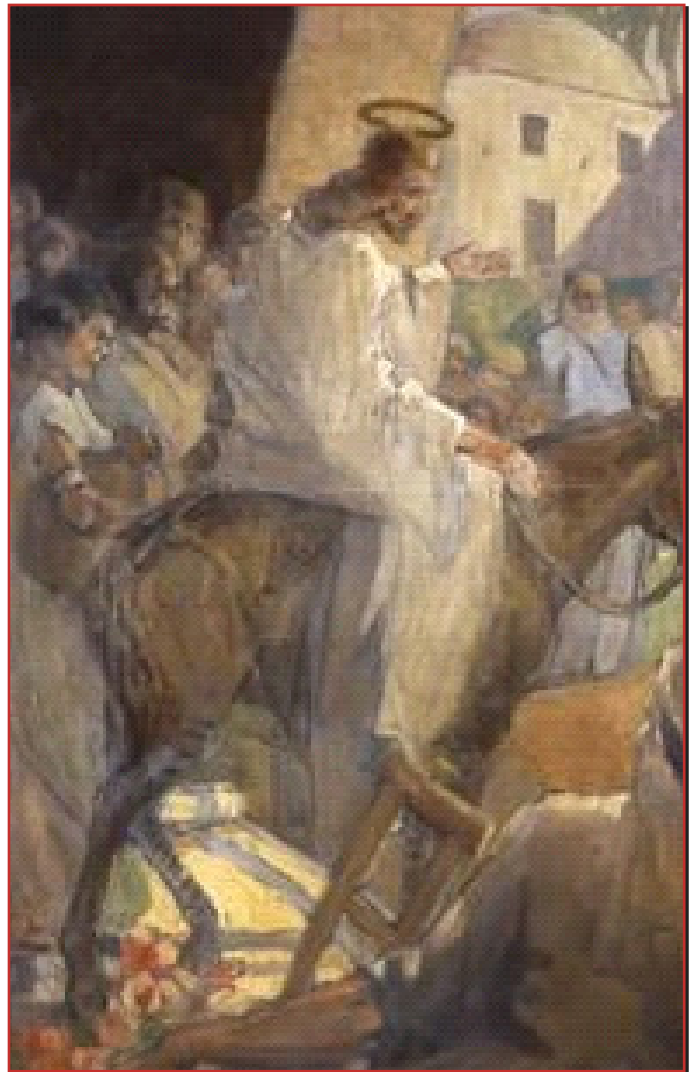

PALM SUNDAY of the PASSION of the LORD

APRIL 14, 2019

FROM THE PASTOR

Today, we celebrate Palm Sunday of the Lord's Passion, which is the beginning of Holy Week. Please be attentive to the schedule of liturgies, which is printed elsewhere in this week's bulletin. This is the most "liturgically dense" week of the year and, consequently, a very busy one. I encourage everyone to consider attending, if it's not already your plan, at least one of the Triduum liturgies: Holy Thursday, on which we celebrate the institution of the Eucharist and the priesthood, as well as the *mandatum* (Christ's New Commandment to love one another as He has loved us); Good Friday, on which we remember His Passion and Death on the Cross; and/or the Easter Vigil on Saturday, during which we welcome new Catholics — this year, in fact, we will be welcoming 11 new Catholics to the faith.

Following the Holy Thursday Mass, nocturnal adoration will take place in the chapel until 7 a.m. on Good Friday morning — consider watching with the Lord for an hour, commemorating the time of prayer in the Garden of Gethsemane prior to His arrest and trial.

On Good Friday, in addition to the liturgy at 3 p.m., there will be an outdoor Living Stations of the Cross (bi-lingual English and Spanish) on the parish grounds beginning at 6 p.m.

On Wednesday of this week (Spy Wednesday), altar servers will rehearse the Triduum liturgies in the church beginning at 10 a.m. That practice should be over by 12 Noon at the latest.

On Holy Saturday, volunteers will be needed to help decorate the church, beginning at 10 a.m. This process usually only takes 60 to 90 minutes. If you've time to spare that morning, please come out to help.

Please note there are no confessions on Holy Saturday — by ancient tradition, no Sacraments are celebrated on Holy Saturday, except those for persons in danger of death.

Finally, please note that the parish office is CLOSED on Good Friday and Easter Monday.
