From the Pastor's Desk,

In 2007, I was blessed to lead a pilgrimage to the Holy Land. Part of the trip, included the opportunity to celebrate Mass in the Holy Sepulchre in Jerusalem. I was inside the tomb celebrating the Holy Mass and when I came out to give the homily, my message then is the message I give to you. "The tomb is empty!" So many of the places of pilgrimage in our faith are popular because they are sites that were visited by the Lord, Mary, or one of the Saints. The tomb, which is the most holy site, is celebrated not because he was there but because he is not there. It is the fact that the tomb is empty that is the cause for our Joy. HE IS RISEN! I pray that all of you have a very blessed Easter season and that your celebration of the resurrection ignites your faith and strengthens you as you walk through life knowing that as His tomb is empty we may live so that our tomb will empty too on the last day.

NEXT WEEK. On April 3rd, we celebrate the feast of the Divine Mercy. Being that this year is also the Jubilee Year of Mercy, we will start a novena of the Divine Mercy which will be celebrated each day for 9 days ending on Apr.11th. The intention for the novena is for the healing of all the sick of the parish and their extended family and the infirm priests of our diocese. On Sunday Apr. 3rd, to begin the novena we will have celebration of the Rite of Anointing of the Sick for those who need it. We will light candles (from the Shrine in Lourdes) for our personal intentions.
