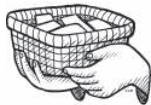

# Guide to the Catechism of the Catholic Church

## The Real Presence

Alfred McBride, O.Praem., Article #42

*“This presence is called real, not to exclude other types of Christ’s presence, but to say this is a substantial presence by which Christ, God and man, makes himself entirely present,”* Catechism, 1374. Mother Angelica attributes the effectiveness of her television and short-wave radio ministry to the graces that come from the perpetual adoration of the Eucharist by her and her sisters at their monastery in Birmingham. Similarly, Mother Teresa and her sisters draw strength for their service to the poorest of the poor from the Mass and adoration of the Real Presence of Jesus in the Eucharist.

### ***The Bread of Life***

Chapter Six of John’s Gospel records Christ’s dialogue at the Capernaum synagogue about the Bread of Life (Jn 6:22-71). He had recently performed the miracle of the multiplication of the loaves and fishes and fed five thousand people. Now, He promised to nourish them with supernatural bread. Eight times He told them He was the living bread come down from heaven. Four times He insisted they must eat His flesh and drink His blood in order to have eternal life here and hereafter. At first, they thought He was speaking metaphorically, but Jesus emphasized and repeated His teaching. They asked disbelievingly, “How can this man give us his flesh to eat?” Jesus did not soften His words. He did not correct misunderstandings. He meant what He said, “My flesh is true food and my blood is true drink” (v.55). Many of His listeners were disciples—they were used to His miracles and mysterious sayings, but they could not accept this. This is the clearest example in the Gospel of someone rejecting Jesus over a doctrinal matter.

### ***Faith Alone Can See and Believe***

The early Fathers of the Church all affirmed the truth of the Real Presence of Jesus in the Eucharist. St. Athanasius says, “After the great prayers, the bread is the Body and the wine is the Blood of Jesus.” Since the Middle Ages the Church has called the process by which this comes about “transubstantiation.” By the power of the Spirit and the words of the priest, the bread and wine are changed into the body, blood, soul, and divinity of Jesus Christ. The bread and wine still look the same, but their reality has changed. Faith alone can see and believe this. We reserve the Eucharist in the tabernacle both for Communion for the sick and as an opportunity for adoration and meditation by the faithful. St. John Vianney loved to sit before the tabernacle. “I look at Jesus and He looks at me.” This powerful devotion increases our love for the Mass and the effectiveness of our service to family, friends, and community.

### **Reflection**

What does the Council of Trent say about the Real Presence?

“Immediately after the consecration, the true body and blood of our Lord, together with his soul and divinity, exist under the species of bread and wine” (Catechism, 1376).

What is the basis for reserving the Eucharist?

The Eucharistic presence of Christ begins at the moment of transubstantiation and remains as long as the Eucharistic species exist (Catechism, 1377).

What is the value of Eucharistic devotion?

Jesus wished to leave us a memorial of his love. In His Eucharistic presence He remains mysteriously in our midst as one who loves us and is delivered for us. The Church and the world have a great need for Eucharistic devotion. Jesus awaits us in the sacrament of love. We should make time to meet Him in adoration, in full faith contemplation, to make reparation for the grave faults and sins of the world (Catechism, 1380).

### **Prayer**

*Eucharistic Jesus, I adore you with all my heart. Under these visible signs you are really present. In contemplating you, all else fades away. Increase my love of you, others, and self.*
