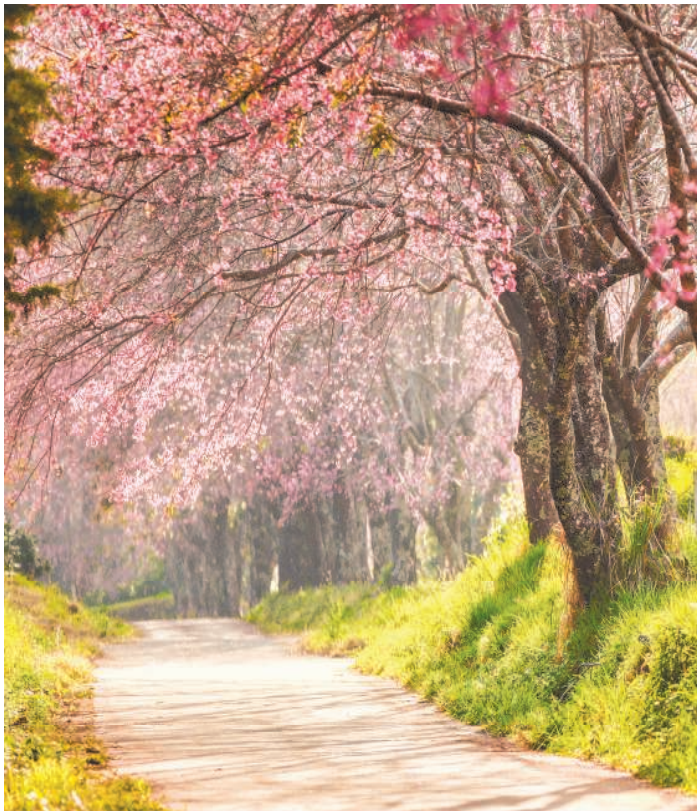

### Sunday, March 6

Have you recently upgraded any of your technological gadgets? Do you have some old movies you no longer watch? Kids moved out and left all their old games? Are these items in such a condition that donating isn't a liable option? Did you know stores like Best Buy, Staples, and Office Depot will take back old electronics? For the more obscure items, MRC Recycling (located in Northeast KC) touts that it will recycle anything that plugs in!

### Sunday, March 13

Burying perfectly good glass in the landfill wastes all the material, energy, and labor that went into making it. And even though curbside recycling does not accept glass, it's still easy to recycle your empty glass containers and bottles in Kansas City. 
