is the public worship of the Catholic Church. Also it is the most important prayer of the Church. The two major parts of the Mass are the Liturgy of the word and the Liturgy of the Eucharist.

Introductory Rites: Entrance, Greeting, Penitential Act, Gloria, Collect (Opening Prayer).

Liturgy of the Word

First Reading, Responsorial Psalm, Second Reading, Gospel Acclamation, Gospel, Homily, Profession of Faith and General Intercessions.

Liturgy of the Eucharist

Presentation of the Gifts and Preparation of the Altar, Prayer over the Offering, Preface, Holy, Holy, Holy, Eucharistic Prayer, Sign of Peace, Lamb of God, Communion and Prayer after Communion.
