Brothers and Sisters,

I have some unfortunate news to share with you. Recently a visitor to our parish received a consecrated Host during Holy Communion and proceeded to flush our Lord's Body and Blood down the toilet in the women's restroom(!). Although she intended no malice, such an act defies explanation. I was able eventually to find her and speak to her personally, sharing with her the gravity of the act (Canon Law, canon 1367), and have offered to help her in rectifying her situation before she could return to the Sacraments. It astounds me that there could be such disregard for our Lord's Body and Blood, and I want to remind us all that no consecrated Host should ever leave the immediate area around the sanctuary unless it is in a pyx and carried by a commissioned Extraordinary Minister. If you ever see someone take the Blessed Sacrament out of that area without consuming the Host, please gently stop that person and let me or one of the Extraordinary Ministers know immediately so that this desecration never happens again.

On a happier note, as we continue to cultivate a Eucharistic Parish here at CTK, I wanted to update you on the process of upgrading our IT system and making it consistent for the entire parish physical plant (office, school, center and church). Very soon we should have internet capability throughout the parish center and into the church so that we can install security cameras in and around the church. This will allow us to keep the church open during the day for people to pray and eventually for more Eucharistic Adoration.

I would like to encourage all those who read or are interested in Matthew Kelly's book, *The Biggest Lie In the History of Christianity*, to come to our discussion of that book this Saturday morning, February 16th, in the parish center. We will be able to view some short videos of Matthew Kelly explaining the book and have discussion questions at the tables. See you there.
