- Institute a program for families or small groups to develop deeper habits of prayer

- Create more opportunities for Eucharistic Adoration and produce materials to aid adoration
- Increase attendance at First Saturday Devotion

- Enhance the liturgical celebration through Sacred Music by developing a program of Sacred Music

- Create a marriage preparation program for those preparing for marriage or the convalidation of their civil marriage
- Encourage small groups of married couples for fellowship, prayer, and support

- Encourage parishioners to invite family, friends and neighbors to come to Mass and fellowship opportunities
- Highlight events (within and outside the parish) using display easels in church and social media
- Increase parish social media presence
- Institute a parish-wide annual event fundraiser
- Develop connections with La Salle faculty, staff and students

CATHOLIC YOUTH AND YOUNG ADULT MINISTRY, VOCATIONS

CHAMPION: JILL BRACKENBROUGH

- Foster vocation through greater participation of youth events, e.g.; Project Andrew/Miriam Dinners, Quo Vadis Days, Nun Run, 6th Grade Vocation Rally and other Archdiocesan initiatives
- Education our youth about their Catholic faith relation to current moral, social and religious issues and teach them to defend their Catholic faith
- Establish a young adult outreach
- Evaluate other Young and Young Adult programs to institute best practices
- Expand our youth program through mission trips,retreats and conferences, and increase exposure to evangelizing and social outreach opportunities
- Actively promote the youth evangelization program through branding and marketing
- Produce "Spiritual Care Packages" for graduation high school seniors listing nearest Catholic churches, campus Newman Centers and other Catholic campus groups and include a crucifix, bible, catechism and rosary

WORKS OF MERCY

CHAMPION: JUDITH LAZO

- Develop a plan for more social outreach into the wider community
- Develop a plan for broader participation in parish volunteer opportunities by encouraging members of various ministries to invite others to join his/her ministry
- Highlight a ministry through parish social media once a month

PARISH-SCHOOL INTEGRATION

CHAMPION: BRIAN TIMM

- Involve school children at Sunday Mass
- Host a Parish picnic for school families following the 10:30 Mass
- Publish parish events in the school "FE" and school events in the parish bulletin
- Open school events to non-school parish families
- Monthly children-focused Mass, children's choir, greeters, gift bearers, altar servers' and readers
- Encourage parishioners to adopt a school family and bring them to church
- Use the parish center and back of church (display cases) to communicate school events, awards, artwork, etc. to parishioners
- Promote the Catholic identity of the school
- Invite Silver Disciples or retired persons to adopt a child and write to them or visit them at school
- Increase a religious presence in the school
